Weapons Proficiency Identification Card Application

Honorably Retired Peace Officers

This is an application for an identification card to identify a person as an honorably retired peace officer who has demonstrated weapons proficiency as authorized by the provisions of the Texas Occupations Code; Title 10, Section 1701.357. For purposes of this application Honorably Retired means a former peace officer who:

- a. Previously served but is not currently serving as an elected, appointed, or employed peace officer under Art. 2.12., code of Criminal Procedure, or other law;
- b. Did not retire in lieu of any disciplinary action;
- c. Was eligible to retire from a law enforcement agency in this state or was ineligible to retire only as a result of an injury received in the course of the officer's employment with the agency; and
- d. Is eligible to receive a pension or annuity for service as a law enforcement officer in this state or is ineligible to receive a pension or annuity only because the law enforcement agency that employed the officer does not offer a pension or annuity to its employees.

ACTION NEEDED BY YOU:

- 1. Read this application carefully
- 2. Sign the application as a verification of the accuracy of the information submitted
- 3. Take the application, Certificate of Proficiency and Honorably Retired Identification Card to 1124 South IH35 (COA Housing Authority), 3rd floor, CTM Security office.
- 4. Report lost or stolen ID cards immediately to APD Watch Commander at 974-0913.
