Weapons Proficiency Identification Card Application

Honorably Retired Peace Officers

This is an application for an identification card to identify a person as an honorably retired peace officer who has demonstrated weapons proficiency as authorized by the provisions of the Texas Occupations Code; Title 10, Section 1701.357. For purposes of this application Honorably Retired means a former peace officer who:

- a. Previously served but is not currently serving as an elected, appointed, or employed peace officer under Art. 2.12., code of Criminal Procedure, or other law;
- b. Did not retire in lieu of any disciplinary action;
- c. Was eligible to retire from a law enforcement agency in this state or was ineligible to retire only as a result of an injury received in the course of the officer's employment with the agency; and
- d. Is eligible to receive a pension or annuity for service as a law enforcement officer in this state or is ineligible to receive a pension or annuity only because the law enforcement agency that employed the officer does not offer a pension or annuity to its employees.

ACTION NEEDED BY YOU:

1. Read this application carefully
2. Sign the application as a verification of the accuracy of the information submitted
3. Take the application, Certificate of Proficiency and Honorably Retired Identification Card to 1124 South IH35 (COA Housing Authority), 3rd floor, CTM Security office.
4. Report lost or stolen ID cards immediately to APD Watch Commander at 974-0913.
