

## **Harold James Moe**

Harold James Moe, 85, of Georgetown, passed away on March 7, 2019.

He was a long time, active resident of Pflugerville and then Marble Falls before finally moving to Georgetown.

Harold belonged to the Lutheran Church and the Austin Police Retired Officers Association. He was also a proud veteran of the United States Air Force.
