Born in Princeton, Kentucky in 1944, Jefferson Rodman was the oldest son of Jack and June Rodman. The son of a military father, Jeff grew up in several towns, from Kentucky and Oklahoma, then finally to Texas.

As a child, he learned the importance of taking care of family, a belief that would be carried with him throughout his life. Jeff followed in his father's footsteps serving and retiring both in the military with the Texas National Guard (earning the rank of First Sergeant) and in law enforcement with the Austin Police Department.

In his spare time, he enjoyed travelling (RVing) and could often be found in the garage "piddling" with classic cars. He was often surrounded by friends (he would often reminisce about the trips to Hunt, TX) and enjoyed spending time with his family.

Affectionately known as "Grumpy" at work, Jeff took greater pride in another nickname- "Papa" to his grandchildren, Alexander, Paxton, and Avery.

He is survived by his wife of 53 years, Cosette, and his children, Dr. Jason Rodman and Tracie Kronmiller.
