

Sam Warren

Sam Warren (AP 368), retired Senior Sergeant, passed away in the early morning hours of Sunday, September 22nd, in Cedar Park, Texas, while surrounded by family.

Sam started with APD as a Police Aide in the early 60s, then dispatched for a while before finally attending the academy and becoming an officer shortly after his 21st birthday in 1966. During his career he worked in patrol, motors, robbery/homicide, forgery, was the first Chief of Hospital Police at Brackenridge Hospital, and retired in 1995 as a Senior Sergeant of the storied APD Motors Unit.

Sam also had a 30-plus year military career, retiring as a Chief Warrant Officer-4. He flew several different helicopters during his decades of service in the Army and National Guard and ended his career as a pilot on active duty with the Texas Reconnaissance and Interdiction Detachment. Sam is survived by his wife of 51 years, B.K. Warren, his daughter Tara Stewart and her husband Josh, son Bodie Warren (Current APD Officer assigned to the Violent Crimes Task Force) and his wife Tracy, as well as 5 grandchildren, 2 sisters and numerous cousins and loved ones.
